Problems faced by all 4 evaluators

- Professor — graduate student research relationship
- Demand for cost-inclusive evaluation (by sites, by professor)

evaluator	human service evaluated
Lana Wald	cognitive-behavioral versus lightbox treatments for Seasonal Affective Disorder
Sarah Hornack	gender-sensitive intensive inpatient programs for substance abuse
Katheryn Ryan	drug therapy versus psychotherapy for patients with diabetes and depression
Jay Gorman	Clubhouse programs for persons with severe mental illness

What unique problems in evaluation were faced by these evaluators

evaluator	advantages	problems
Lana Wald	well-funded clinical trial	static costs and benefits self-report questionnaire
Sarah Hornack	large data set, others' research	remote, multiple sites, nonrandom assignment, not designed for cost-inclusive evaluation
Katheryn Ryan	large data set already available	nonrandom assignment large large sample sizes
Jay Gorman	pre-existing database	remote, multiple sites, missing data, data collection over different time periods, different tools
