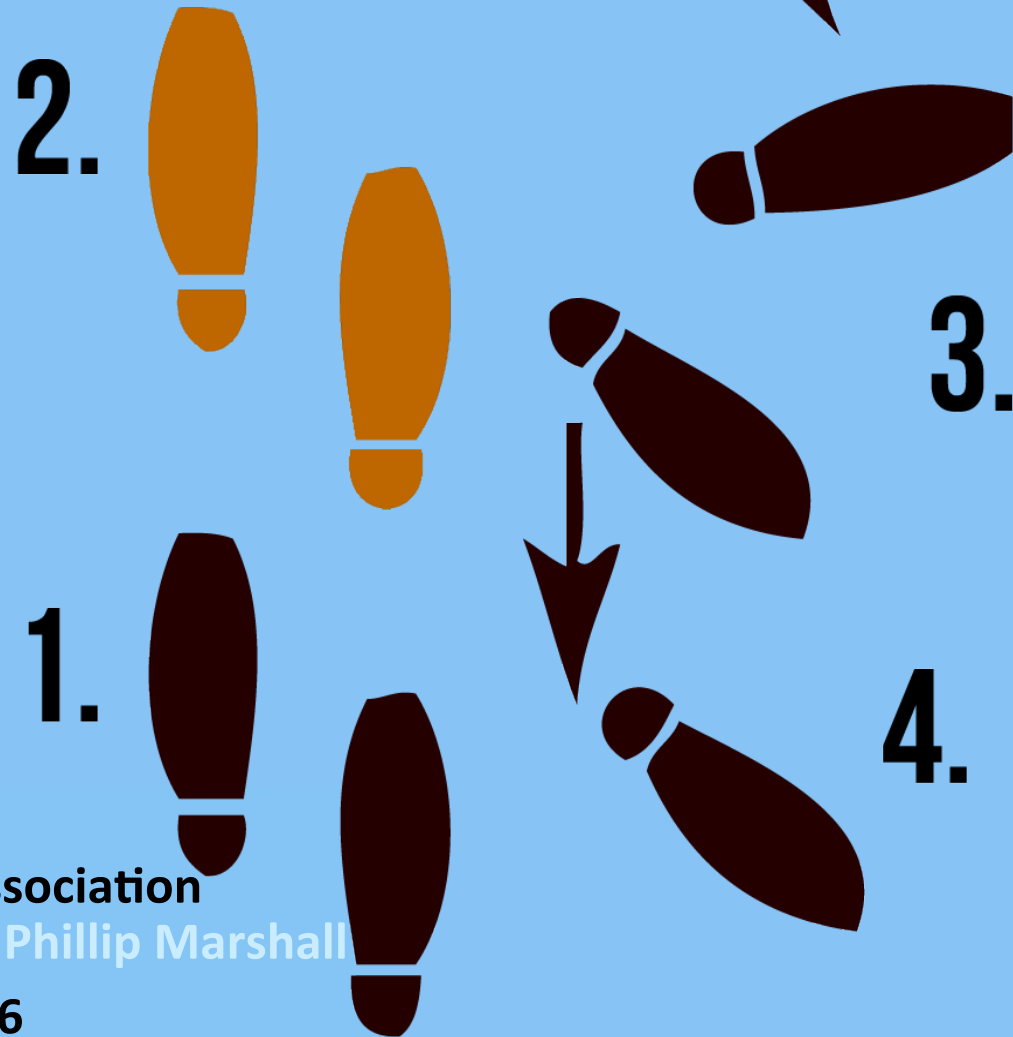

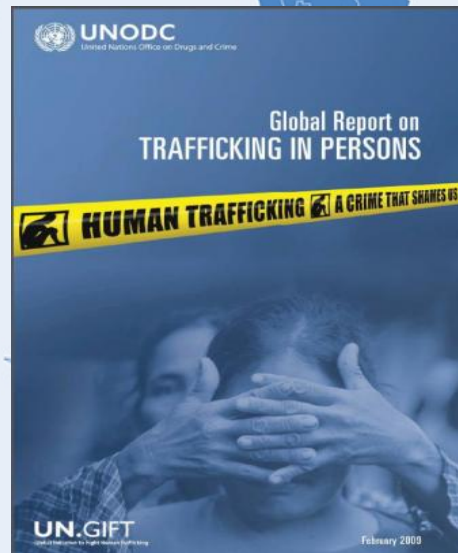

Need for CTIP programmes with evidence of effectiveness

Develop a road map for strengthening CTIP efforts + accumulating an evidence base

Assemble, sort, and access AK from CTIP + related sectors

## STEP 2

Build an MEL framework informed by previous CTIP evaluation + practice

Employ AK in refining and strengthening CTIP policies, practices, + programmes

## STEP 3

Develop shared framework-based MEL resources + tools

Implement AK-informed CTIP efforts

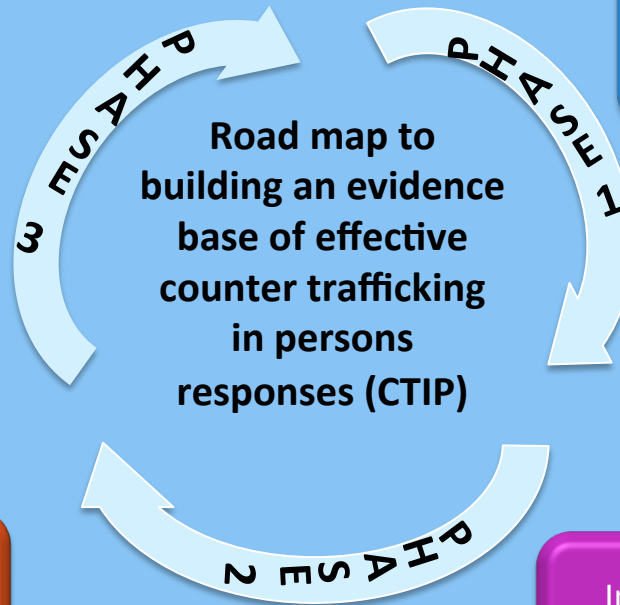

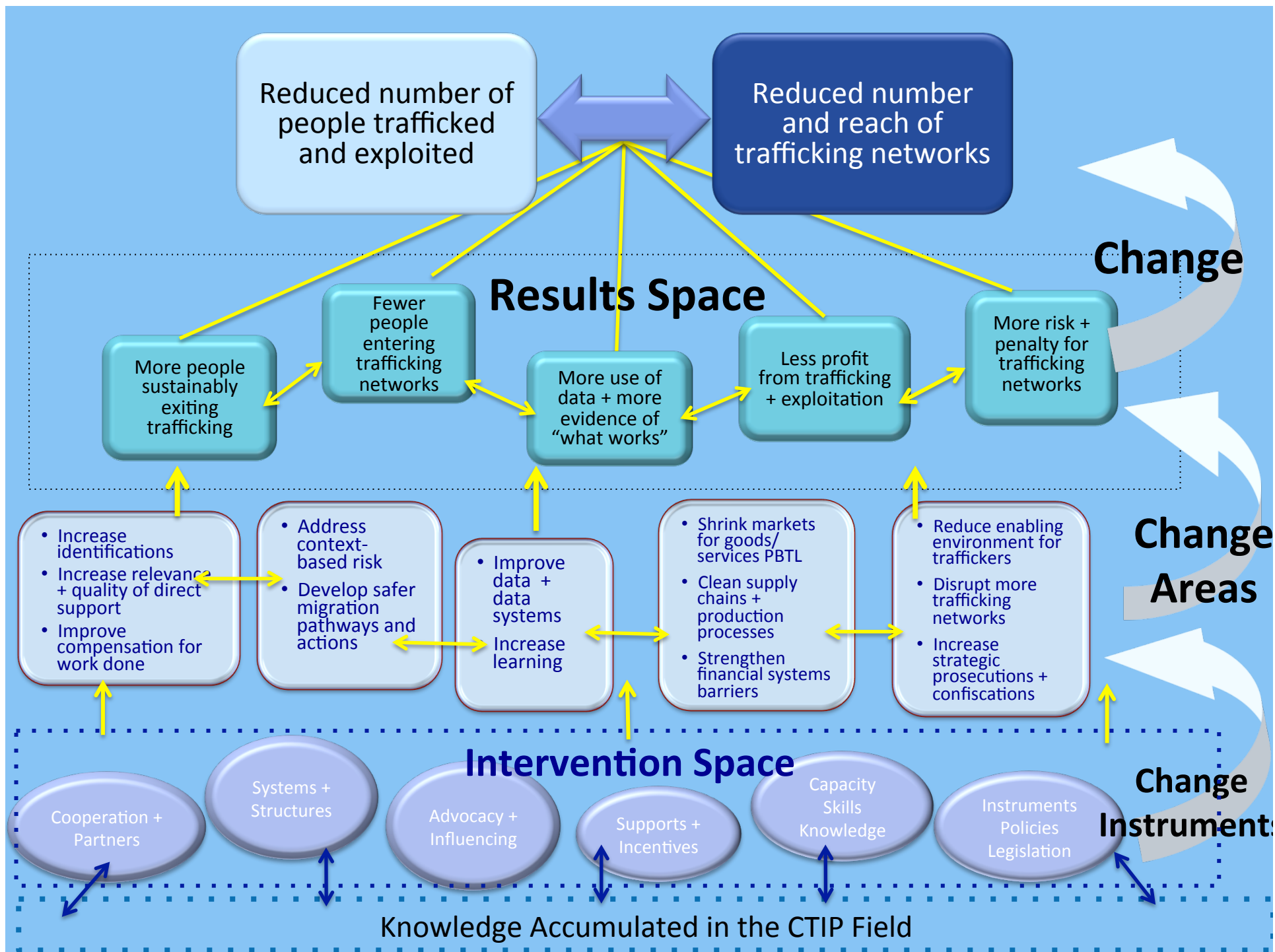
