




## Primary Employment Income & Weekly Hours






## Primary Employment Setting Income & Weekly Hours






#### Hours and Compensation\* for Professors & Consultants





## Compensation For Primary Position by Years






#### Percent Reporting Additional Income






## Income Breakdown for Members Who Reported Multiple Sources




### Region Map






### Income by Ethnicity\*





### Income by Degree Type




