DD participants are earning more per income month than CADI participants.

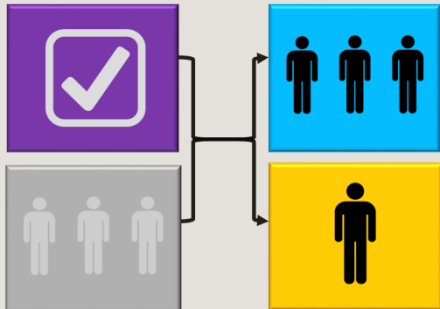


Why do you think there a difference between the two programs?

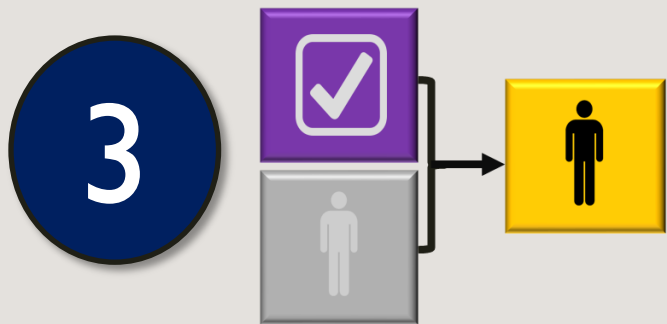
