

- It is a way of keeping the evaluation transparent.



MISRGO Evaluation Progress Report. The 2010 Progress Report has been issued. It is currently being reviewed by the MISRGO Advisory Board (February 3, 2010).

The report highlights MISRGO's and the grantees' efforts to launch a new evaluation monitoring and reporting system. Each grantee is

now required to establish a baseline, specify program goals, and develop realistic benchmarks (to help guide and monitor program performance).
